The Schedule

27-28 JUNE 2020; (1 NIGHT)

Legendary Lodge, Arusha, Tanzania

Arrive at Kilimanjaro International Airport (JRO). You will be warmly welcomed and escorted to Legendary Lodge, where you will relax, enjoy the grounds and cuisine. Dine at your leisure, depending on when you arrive. If you would like to arrange for an additional night, we can easily add it to the itinerary. An additional night will give you more time to relax after the long journey, take advantage of the amazing property as well as go shopping locally. If you would like to arrive one day earlier, we already have a hold on some rooms to acommodate you if you would like to spend a day swimming, using the work out facilities, getting over jet-lag or doing some shopping. We will have to release the space at some point, though, so look into flights as soon as possible.

28 JUNE 2020

Fly to the Serengeti from Arusha Airport

Today you will have breakfast at Legendary Lodge and make the short drive over to the Arusha Airport in time to take your charter flight to the Serengeti. You will fly over the famed Ngorongoro Crater on your way to the central and western part of the Serengeti. The flight will take around an hour, flying over the expansive plains that are home to lion prides, elephant herds and the world famous wildebeest migration.

The Serengeti, Tanzania's second largest national park, covers nearly 6,000 square miles of grassland plains, savannah, kopjes, hills, woodlands, and riverine forests. The Grumeti, Mbalageti, and Mara River systems serve as critical water sources and are often excellent sites for wildlife viewing. Beyond the



heralded migration of wildebeest and zebra, the Serengeti is best known for its big predators, including cheetah and leopard, as well as large prides of lions and clans of hyenas. Other commonly seen animals include gazelle, buffalo, giraffe, topi, hartebeest, ostrich, and jackal. It is the full diversity of wildlife and habitats that you will truly find amazing. The greater Serengeti ecosystem actually covers the Ngorongoro Conservation Area, the Maasai Mara in Kenya, and numerous surrounding wildlife-protected lands that combine for a total of almost 17,000 square miles, which is larger than the states of Massachusetts, Connecticut, and Rhode Island all together.

Most of us know about the "Great Migration" from nature programs that capture some of the most thrilling moments on film. Often misunderstood, the migration is a perpetual, year-round process involving over one million wildebeest and 200,000 zebra who roam the plains quietly, in search of food and water. While some antelope and hyena may follow the herds, other animals remain in their territories or have separate migratory patterns. The migration's most dramatic moments often occur when large numbers of wildebeest and zebra make river crossings, during which they must elude predators in a desperate fight for survival. There is no telling exactly when these highly dramatic movements will occur, but all safari-goers are sure to see plenty of wildebeest and zebra while in Tanzania.





29 JUNE 2020

Legendary Expeditions Western Serengeti Seasonal Camp

Today is your first full day in the Serengeti, spending time with big herds and big cats. This is what has made the Serengeti famous worldwide. Wildebeest, zebra, buffalo, and an array of antelope live and travel in large herds. The herds can swell to hundreds of thousands at select times throughout the year



as some of the animals migrate to new lands to get water and food. Lions also live in prides and generally range from 6-12 animals. However, some prides can have as many as forty lions. Both cheetahs and leopards live completely solitary lives once grown. Both have orange-yellowish coats and black spots, but cheetahs are smaller than leopards and have distinguishing dark lines running from their eyes to their jaws. Cheetahs usually reside around open plains, while leopards stick to wooded areas where they can bring their prey into the branches for safe keeping.

June is the time of the year when the wildebeest migration typically makes its way through the central and western regions of the Serengeti. So, let's cross our fingers and put the time in to go in search of the huge herds of grazers that are constantly on the move for fresh grasses. Seeing the great migration will be the highlight of your safari .

30 JUNE 2020

Legendary Expeditions Western Serengeti Seasonal Camp

A typical day in the Serengeti will look something like this: wake up to the sounds of the night and early

morning with a cup of tea or coffee that will be brought to your tent by the staff. Slowly get ready for your morning game drive, gather in the main dining tent for more coffee, tea, granola, toast and fruit. Don't worry about food, because you will be well taken care of for your dining needs. All dining desires and avoidances are handled professionally and without a skip.

After a quick bite you will get in the safari vehicles and depart camp, possibly around sunrise or shortly thereafter. You will check up on the sounds of the night, searching for signs of nighttime activity. We often hear lion roars early in the morning and it is great to head out quickly to see what they are up to, as this tends to be their most active time of the day.

After a relaxing game drive you might come back to camp for a proper breakfast or you may have a bush breakfast brought out to you. The staff loves to mix things up so anything can and will be done for you to exceed your expectations. Sometimes breakfast is at 9am, sometimes it's a brunch at 11am and sometimes you have a proper lunch that is served at 1pm back at camp. One thing is a truism while on safari: you will never ever want for more dining opportunities.

After some time off back at camp you will meet back up for high tea in the mid-afternoon, usually around 3-3:30, head back out on your late afternoon game drive. It is customary to stop at around sunset to enjoy a glass of wine, soda, sparkling wine or beer before heading back to camp. It is great to get out of the vehicle to stretch your legs, enjoy the absolutely stunning landscape and temperature that the Serengeti enjoys year around.

When you arrive back at camp you will likely head back to your tent to wash up, perhpas take a shower and meet at the camp fire for some 'bush television' time. Share stories of what you have seen and experienced during the day. Sit for dinner when you are ready. The camp is all yours to enjoy and noone else will be sharing the camp with you. Laugh and be joyful at dinner and retire to your tent to listen to the sounds of the Serengeti as you doze off.



01 JULY 2020

Western Serengeti flight to Mila Tented Camp, southern Serengeti



Today you will make your way to the Grumeti Airstrip and will fly to the southern region of the Sereneti, where you will be met and driven to your next camp. Legendary Expeditions has a brand new camp that is being built in their private concession, Mwiba. Mila Tented Camp will have six permanent tents in a safari chic design and for your group we are augmenting the camp with six additional tents in order to accommodate the larger group size. Mila Tented Camp is set along a seasonal river and is inside the Mwiba private concession. Within this concession you are able to do guided walks, game drives, a proper hike to the escarpment of Lake Eyasi (recommended) and above all else have time with the Hadzabe hunter and gatherer tribe.

Have a relaxed lunch, settle into Mila Tented Camp and enjoy a guided walk or game drive this afternoon. When you make it back to camp you will be greeted by a fire and a glass of whatever your favorite drink is. The staff will be ready to assist you and a wonderful dinner will be waiting when you are ready.

02-03 JULY 2020

Mila Tented Camp in the souther Serengeti

Two more amazing days in the greater Serengeti, where you will have enormous flexibility of what you do with your time. Our recommendation is to spend time with the Hadzabe tribe, the last hunter and gatherers in east Africa. The Hadzabe number between 1,000 and 1,500 in total and they rely on basic hunting and gathering of honey and other found edible fruits and nuts.

Genetically, the Hadza are not closely related to any other people in Africa. While traditionally classified with the Khoisan languages, the Hadza language (Hadzane) is an island of language in the pop/click family of liguistics. An adventure with the Hadza is not a canned experience and will likely be the highlight of your trip to Tanzania.

Spend the rest of your time at Mila Tented Camp enjoying game drives, guided walks or taking advantage of the camp in its very private setting.

04 JULY, 2020

Mila Tented Camp to Kilimanjaro International Airport and back home

Relish your last views of the Serengeti before flying back to Kilimanjaro International Airport. The flight to Kilimanjaro will take you near Mount Kilimanjaro, so look out for the highest mountain on the African continent at 19,340 feet. You will land in time to get checked in for your flight back to Europe, no matter which flig hts you choose. The most common flights are from KLM (our recommendation), Turkish Airlines (our second recommendation) and Ethiopian Airlines. If you prefer other carriers you can fly into Nairobi and we can arrange flights that connect Nairobi and Kilimanjaro International.

This advance payment is due within five (5) days of making the reservation. There shall be no binding contract until the advance payment has been received by Andy Biggs Safaris & Custom Travel. Failure to remit your advance payment on time will result in an automatic change of status of any confirmed space to a provisional basis and the possible inability to reinstate your reservation. When Andy Biggs Safaris & Custom Travel receives your advance payment, a booking reference number will be assigned and noted on your original invoice. This number shall be deemed to constitute acceptance and confirmation of your booking. Your cancelled check and or wire transfer authority will act as your receipt.

A) "Force Majeure" shall mean that Andy Biggs Safaris & Custom Travel will not be liable for any alleged damages because of any circumstances including, but without limitation, acts of God, explosion, flood, tempest, fire or accident, war or threat of war, sabotage, insurrection, civil disturbance, or requisition, sickness, quarantine, government intervention, weather conditions or other untoward occurrences.

B) If Andy Biggs Safaris & Custom Travel is affected by Force Majeure it shall forthwith notify you of the nature and extent thereof.

C) Andy Biggs Safaris & Custom Travel shall not be deemed to be in breach of these terms and conditions or otherwise be liable to you, by reason of delay in performance, or by non-performance, of any of its obligations hereunder to the extent that any such delay or non-performance is due to any Force Majeure.

A) Although Andy Biggs Safaris & Custom Travel hopes that it would not need to levy surcharges it reserves the right to do so on the invoice amount, if this becomes necessary. Andy Biggs Safaris & Custom Travel will endeavor to notify you in writing as soon as it is ware of any likely surcharge, and you must pay the amount of such surcharge no later than ten (10) days after written notification has been received (depending on the circumstances). If the surcharge is not paid within such time, Andy Biggs Safaris & Custom Travel may construe such non-payment as an act of cancellation on your part and the provisions of Paragraph 2 shall apply.

B) Rates used in the safaris are based on tariffs and exchange rates valid at the time of printing and advertising safaris. Should a rate vary against the U. S. Dollar by more than 3%, Andy Biggs Safaris & Custom Travel reserves the right to recalculate the safari cost and apply the differential as a surcharge. Any refund made by Andy Biggs Safaris & Custom Travel shall be in its absolute and sole discretion.

8) TERMS AND CONDITIONS

These terms and conditions govern the relationship between Andy Biggs Safaris & Custom Travel and you, to the total exclusion of any other terms and conditions.
